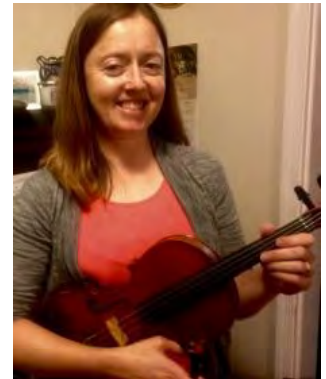
INSTRUCTORS
