- Private weekly lessons beginning September 2021. Suzuki method. 20 Scholarship students, plus five tuition students -- \$20 for each half-hour lesson.

- Parents must attend lessons, and supervise practice during the week. Parents are asked to provide listening experiences as suggested by instructors.
- Students and parents agree to stick with lessons for at least four months.
- Instruments, sized to your child, are FREE. Students choose violin, viola or cello.
